Our September meeting will be a presentation by Patrick Shrader of Picasa, a free software package for processing digital images. Patrick gave us a preview at the August meeting of what he will be covering.

Annual Banquet

Our annual Banquet jointly with the Conestee Falls club will be on September 6. Each of you should have received a notice earlier concerning this.

Conestee folks would like to display some of our work at the banquet along with theirs. Members may submit up to three prints, framed, matted and mounted or just mounted. Prints need to be some that have been submitted to a Forum previously. The folks at Conestee have one requirement. Prints must have a means of hanging them. String or twine taped securely to the back of a mounted or matted print will work as demonstrated by Ron at the August meeting. Use "packing tape" the stuff sold for sealing packages for mailing. I taped a string to the back of the print, leaving extra string past the tape, folded the string back and applied more tape. A mounted print so set up hung for a week on a hook without loosening.

Directions to the Peter & Sandy Jones Residence:

From downtown Hendersonville take Kanuga Road west of town. At the junction with Little River Road, Kanuga Road becomes Crab Creek Road. Continue on Crab Creek Road for approximately 1.5 miles to Kanuga Forest subdivision on the right. Turn into the subdivision on Kanuga Forest Drive and go almost to the top of the street. We are on the left at 417 Kanuga Forest Drive.

Directions to the Conestee Falls Clubhouse:

From all points in Hendersonville, take Kanuga westward, after a few miles it becomes Crabcreek. Continue westward about 7 miles, then turn left onto Dupont Road, Dupont becomes Staton Rd as you enter Transylvania county (remember to wear garlic and carry a cross). Staton goes thru Dupont forest. You pass the Hooker Falls and Triple Falls parking areas, then Staton Road comes to an end at Cascade Lake Rd. Turn left. (turning right leads to a dirt road) Follow Cascade Lake till it ends at US 276. Turn right and go 3 miles till you see the CONNESTEE FALLS EAST FORK GATE sign on your left. Turn left onto East Fork Road for 1/3 mile and enter the East Fork Gate. Sign in at the guard house. Follow the main drag (Connestee Trail) with the yellow center line for about a mile till you see the CLUBHOUSE sign on your right. Enter the parking lot and the clubhouse entrance on the right side of the front of the building.

If leaving from Etowah or any place west of Etowah, take Hwy 64 west. After 64 is joined by US 276, continue on 64 one more traffic light. Turn left onto Ecusta Road. Take Ecusta till it ends at the Old Hendersonville Hwy. Turn right onto OHH for 100 feet, then turn left on Wilson Road. Take Wilson till it end at US 276. Turn left onto US 276, and follow it 6 miles to the second Connestee entrance, The East Fork Entrance. Follow as above.
