Catawba Rhododendron

Our photo-shoot leader, Erika Macklin, will be out of town when the Catawba rhododendron are in full bloom. However, she suggests that members go there around June 16.

This is from Erika:

"There are two places of these blooms where you will be greatly rewarded. Roan Mountain (Carver's Gap TN & NC border)or Craggy Gardens on the Blue Ridge Parkway.



If you choose Roan Mountain you may want to hike all the way to Grassy Ridge Bald, 2.4 miles with great vista on the way. There you will see another whole bald in the distance completely covered with blooms. If you are lucky, you will also find Gray's Lilies along the trail. You can also visit the Rhododendron Gardens if you are not able or willing to hike.

If you are at Craggy Gardens, you can take a short 0.4 mile hike to the bald which has beautiful blooms on top. You can also go past the Visitor Center and through the tunnel and park in the lot on the left where you can hike up to Craggy Pinnacle. There you have a 360 degree view and also many rhodies along the way."
