2020 Inter-Club Competition

Overview:

Hands Across the Sea - [Camera Club of Hendersonville](#) and the [City of London and Cripplegate Photographic Society \(London\)](#)

The score is tied at 1 each! The London Club won the competition last year so this year is the tie breaker. This friendly competition is designed to provide an opportunity for the photographers in each club to submit digital images in four broad categories. Each club will then choose 20 images (5 in each category) to be submitted to the online competition.

The competition will be judged by **Damien Demolder** who is a highly accomplished London based photographer and teacher. <https://damiendemolder.com>

Time line:

For your work to be considered each photographer must submit their images to their respective clubs by midnight 29 February 2020. Each club will then decide which 20 images to put forward for the competition and the deadline for this is 29 March 2020.

The entries will be judged during April 2020 and the winner and scores will subsequently be announced.

Image categories:

The four image categories for this year are:

- Night
- Wild
- Home
- Time and Place

Photographers are free to photographically illustrate these categories as they wish.

Submission of images:

Individuals can initially submit as many images for consideration in each category as they like. Each club will decide on the final 5 images in each of the 4 categories to put forward. Any individual photographer can only have one picture in each category. However an individual photographer can have 4 images chosen as long as they are in 4 separate categories.

### Mechanics:

- Submitted images must be in .jpg format. For best results, save them in SRGB color space.
- With any submission, all post production work must be done by the maker of the image.
- Size your images to fit a 1400 by 1050 monitor screen. That means that horizontal or landscape images should be 1400 pixels wide, whereas vertical or portrait formats will be 1050 pixels high.
- No names, watermarks, copyrights or signatures are to appear on the image.
- Participants will email images as attached files (NOT imbedded in the text) to the two Club Coordinators:
